| 21 | This Enactment may be cited as the "Inauguration Committee Act."         |

| 23 | SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT.   |

| 25 | There is established an AD HOC joint committee with the Student          |
| 26 | Activities Board (SAB) to be known as the "The Joint Committee on        |
| 27 | Inaugural Events" (in this Enactment referred to as the "Committee").    |

| 29 | SEC. 3. DUTIES OF COMMITTEE.   |

| 31 | The Committee shall:   |

| 33 | <i>i</i> . plan, develop, and carry out such activities as the Committee |
| 34 | considers fitting and proper to commemorate the execution of             |
| 35 | offices of the several officials of the Student Government               |

| 38 | <i>ii.</i> to work with the Director of Student Programs and Activities, |
| 39 | Vice-Chancellor of Student Affairs, and other University officials in    |

| 9        | (a) The Committee shall be composed of ten (10) members as follows:   |

| 11       | <i>i</i> . Five (5) Senators appointed by the Senate President Pro-tempore.   |

| 13       | <i>ii</i> . Five (5) SAB members appointed by the SAB Chairperson.  |

| 15       | (b) Each member shall be appointed for the life of the Committee.   |

| 17       | (c) All members of the Committee shall be appointed not later than five   |
| 18       | (5) days after the date of the enactment of this Act.   |

| 20       | (d) A vacancy on the Committee shall:   |

| 22       | <i>i</i> . not affect the powers of the Committee; and  |

| 24       | <i>ii.</i> be filled in the manner in which the original appointment was  |

| 27       | (e) A majority of the members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum  |

| 33       | SEC. 5. POWERS OF COMMITTEE.  |

| 11       | (a) The Committee shall submit to the President and the Senate monthly        |
| 12       | reports on the progress and revenue and expenditures of the Committee,        |
| 13       | including a list of each gift, bequest, or devise to the Committee, together  |
| 14       | with the identity of the donor of each gift, bequest, or devise.              |

| 16       | (b) The Committee may submit to the President and Congress interim            |
| 17       | reports as the Committee considers appropriate.                               |

| 19       | (c) Not later than April 17, 2009, the Committee shall submit a final report  |
| 20       | to the President and the Congress containing:                                 |

| 22       | <i>i</i> . a summary of the activities of the Committee;                      |

| 35       | objectives, as laid out in section 3.   |
