24 the bill, now known as Act 100 of 1909 or the Bellamy Act, into law
25 creating four public schools of agriculture within the state; and

27 **WHEREAS**, one the four schools created by the Bellamy Act was the Fourth
28 District Agricultural School located in Monticello, Arkansas; and

30 **WHEREAS**, one-hundred years later the same institution is still organized, but
31 under the name the University of Arkansas at Monticello; and

33 **WHEREAS**, on Wednesday, April 1, 2009, the University of Arkansas at
34 Monticello celebrated its one-hundredth year of institution in a Centennial
35 Convocation Ceremony held in the campus' amphitheatre; and

37 **WHEREAS**, the ceremony suitably, and flawlessly, reflected the long history,
38 heritage, and legacy of this great institution with dignity and honor; in which
39 echoed the union the tens-of-thousands of people who have been influenced
40 by this establishment; be it by the Fourth District Agricultural School, the

1 Fourth District Agricultural and Mechanical College, Arkansas A & M
2 College, or the University of Arkansas at Monticello.
